



ANZICS Conference Scholarships New Zealand College of Critical Care Nurses - NZNO November 11-13th 2024 - Auckland

Two scholarships are being offered by the New Zealand College of Critical Care Nurses (NZCCCN) to support nurses' attendance at the ANZICS regional annual scientific meeting, 11-13th November 2024.

The scholarships are funded by donations from the New Zealand ANZICS executive. The goal of the scholarships is to enrich nursing knowledge and practice in the area of critical care nursing.

Scholarship objectives:

- 1. To assist nurses to develop their knowledge of nursing care of critically ill patients.
- 2. To assist nurses to develop their clinical inquiry in to nursing care of critically ill patients.
- 3. To advance the development of clinical nursing care of the critically ill.
- 4. To encourage research into critical care nursing practice.

Scholarship:

Able to be used for:

- Registration Full nursing registration fee, \$635
- Accommodation This will be pre booked for you due to limited availability. Please advise if you wish to stay with whanau/friends
- Travel Return flights to Auckland, or reasonable private travel costs (Maximum \$500, depending on location)
- Transfers Airport transfers
- Insurance against cancellation due to unforeseen circumstances

Please note that this scholarship does not include attendance at the annual New Zealand research meeting.

Who should apply?

Registered Nurses working with critically ill patients in New Zealand, who are current NZCCCN members (NZNO), and have been 3 months prior to application. You must be able to attend this event in full on November 11-13th 2024.

Selection Criteria:

Successful applicants will be selected by the NZCCCN National Committee. The committee's decision is final and no further correspondence will be entered into.

Applicants must meet all the following selection criteria:

- Be a NZCCCN member (NZNO) at the time of this application and on 31st March 2024
- Be a registered nurse currently working with critically ill patients in New Zealand
- Commit to providing a short article about a topic of interest from a session attended at the conference for publication in the December issue of NZCCCN newsletter, Critical Comment.
- Complete the attached application form
- Provide a current curriculum vitae
- No previous successful application for a NZCCCN scholarship
- Commit to attend the three days of the ANZICS conference
- Have not received funding from elsewhere to attend
