Course in Applied Physiology in Emergency Nursing - A Conceptual Approach

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ABOUT THE COURSE:

PURPOSE

CAPEN is a 2 day comprehensive course designed to give acute care clinicians the ability to correlate broad physiologic / pathophysiologic processes to specific clinical problems.

The course teaches a conceptual approach of advanced physiological principles and human responses related to injury and illness. The course utilizes a case study approach and critical decision-making skills and combines didactic content with interactive discussions and is presented in a flexible format.

By undertaking this course, the clinician will strengthen their complex critical decision-making skills to optimally impact the outcome of critically ill or injured patients.

Upon completion of the course the participant should be able to:

- Analyse physiologic concepts as they relate to human responses to injury
- Integrate the physiologic concepts through case studies
- Utilize the application of science to clinical practice with the physiologic concepts to assure a comprehensive approach to the injured patient
- Evaluate the effectiveness of clinical management on patient outcomes

Course participants are expected to be familiar with core anatomy and physiology. A participant workbook and Physiology Text is provided prior to course attendance which is to be completed and handed in the morning of Day 1 to assist in achieving maximum benefit during the course. Not all the answers are in the textbook, it is provided as a resource only. There is a case study to attempt on the night of Day 1. It is also recommended that course participants understand the Primary and Secondary surveys related to trauma management.
