Dr Michal Boyd is a nurse practitioner who works privately in residential aged care facilities with Equinox Health Ltd and holds Honorary Associate Professor position. Her main research interests are care of older adultsliving with frailty and dementia in the community and those living residential aged care, as well as advanced nursing practice. She was primary investigator for the "End of life with dementia" study, and has recently completed the Deterioration Early Warning System (with Julie Daltrey) for residential aged care, both funded by the Ageing Well National Science Challenge.
