

Treasurer Report 2024 Annual General Meeting College of Respiratory Nurses New Zealand – NZNO

Financial Commentary

The College Financial accounts show a net surplus of \$3,779 against a budgeted deficit of \$10,266 for the year ending 31 March 2024.

Income and Expenditure

The total income for the 23/24 financial year was \$12,558.44 with expenses totalling \$6635.24, resulting in the aforementioned net surplus after tax of \$3779.17. This compares to a surplus after tax of \$4,887 in 22/23.

This positive result is due to the following factors:

- Expenditure for 2023/24 was less than budgeted.
- Knowledge and Skills Framework review budget not utilised due to it having not yet commenced and not requiring face to face meetings to date.
- Grant expenditure has been less than budget due to less applications.
- Some early expenses related to Symposium have not yet been budgeted for.
- Accommodation and meals for Committee meetings has been less than budget due to less overnight requirements.

Statement of Financial Position

The College of Respiratory Nurses ended the financial year on 31 March 2024 with cash at the bank (including term deposits) totalling \$87,381.67 compared to \$85,451 on 31 March 2023. The cash at bank year ending 31 March 2024 is greater than the budget projection of \$73,337.00.
